- Ensure 100% of students in Years 3 & 5 meet National Minimum Standards in Literacy and Numeracy, or have an Individual Curriculum Plan in place.
- Ensure 100% student improvement in early start focus areas.
- Ensure 100% student improvement on math pre- to post-test.

Our initiatives include

- Developing staff capability for implementing higher order thinking and open ended tasks through a range of professional development.
- Implementing an observation and feedback cycle between principals in the cluster – both via direct and video observation.
- Embedding use of CARS and STARS reading strategies.
- Developing phonological awareness skills throughout the whole school.
- Analysing local and system data to inform teaching practices and future focus.
- Providing targeted feedback to students and unpack feedback as a class.
- Using a range of rapid recall routines to develop automaticity in basic literacy skills.
- Developing individual goals to target areas for improvement based on NAPLAN re-sit data.
- Utilising staff to focus teaching and learning in small groups.

Employing human resources to support the teaching of literacy and numeracy.	\$4 240
Developing staff capacity and capability on the teaching of open ended tasks and the supporting of literacy and numeracy skills.	\$2 500
Purchasing a 'Swivl' camera robot to help support the implementation of observation and feedback cycles both within the school and cluster.	\$550
Purchasing a document camera to help provide feedback to students and develop student capability in understanding and using feedback.	\$200



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
